as amended by Law 7 of 1961.

THE IMPORTATION OF ANIMALS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1965.

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Administrator in Council by section 9 of the Importation of Animals Law, 1934, the following Regulations are hereby made:-

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Importation of Animals (Amendment) Regulations, 1965. Short title.

2. Regulation 7 of the Importation of Animals Regulations, 1961, is hereby deleted and replaced as follows -

“7 (1) A Licence shall not be granted to any person to import any wild animal from the United States of America or Canada.

(2) A dog or cat imported into the Cayman Islands from the United States of America or Canada shall be quarantined in the Cayman Islands for a specified period and at a specified place if the Administrator shall, in his discretion, so direct in the licence to import such dog or cat.”
