### CAYMAN ISLANDS PROCLAMATION NO. 2 OF 2022

BY HIS EXCELLENCY MARTYN ROPER OFFICER OF THE  
MOST EXCELLENT ORDER OF THE BRITISH EMPIRE,  
GOVERNOR OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS

WHEREAS section 84(1) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands provides that the Governor, acting after consultation with the Premier, and by proclamation, may prorogue the Parliament, and shall do so annually:


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Martyn Roper, OBE Governor of the Cayman Islands, by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by section 84(1) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands, after consultation with the Premier, HEREBY PROCLAIM that the Parliament of the Cayman Islands shall be prorogued as from the 12<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2022.
