PROCLAMATION NO. 1 OF 2023

WHEREAS, in 2023 the University of the West Indies is celebrating the seventy-fifth anniversary of its founding in 1948;

AND WHEREAS, the University Of The West Indies, established in 1948 as “a University College in special relationship with the University of London” and given its own Royal Charter as an autonomous University in 1962, is the oldest, fully regional institution of higher learning in the Commonwealth Caribbean;

AND WHEREAS, the University, which is supported by seventeen Caribbean Countries, all current or former colonies of Great Britain, is committed to the development of the region through the training of its human resources, the conduct of research, the delivery of advisory services to governments as well as to the private sector and the forging of links with other institutions in the wider region and the rest of the world;

AND WHEREAS, in 1989 in what is known as “The Declaration of Grand Anse” the Heads of Government of the Caribbean Community reaffirmed their commitment that the University of the West Indies should remain a regional institution indefinitely;

AND WHEREAS, the University of the West Indies is the leading research institution in the region and has, since its establishment, produced more than one hundred thousand graduates in various disciplines thereby significantly contributing to the region’s human capacity;

AND WHEREAS, it was on January 7th, seventy-five years ago that the first meeting of the provisional Council of the University College of the West Indies was held in Jamaica;

NOW THEREFORE, I Martyn Roper, OBE Governor of the Cayman Islands, do hereby proclaim, that Saturday, January 7, 2023 was UWI DAY, and hereby call on all persons in the Cayman Islands, to reflect on the achievements of this important institution and to participate actively in the celebratory activities that will be held throughout this anniversary year.
