**(Law 34 of 2020)**

**A LAW TO APPROPRIATE EXECUTIVE FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS FOR THE  
FINANCIAL YEAR 1 JANUARY 2019 TO 31 DECEMBER 2019**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

## **Short title**

1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (January 2019 to December 2019) Law, 2020.

## **Appropriation authority**

2. The Cabinet may incur executive expenses, acquire executive assets, make equity investments or loans and undertake borrowing for the financial year ending 31 December 2019 in the amounts and for the respective purposes set out in the Schedule.
