MENTAL HEALTH COMMISSION (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2022

AN ACT TO AMEND THE MENTAL HEALTH COMMISSION ACT, 2013 AS A
CONSEQUENCE OF THE ENACTMENT OF THE MENTAL HEALTH (AMENDMENT)
ACT, 2022; AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED PURPOSES

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title and commencement

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Mental Health Commission (Amendment) Act, 2022.
- (2) This Act shall come into force immediately after the *Mental Health (Amendment) Act, 2022* comes into force.

Amendment of section 7 of the Mental Health Commission Act, 2013 - functions of Commission: Quasi-judicial

- The *Mental Health Commission Act, 2013* is amended in section 7 as follows —
 - in paragraph (c), by deleting the word “and” appearing at the end of that paragraph;
 - in paragraph (d), by deleting the full stop and substituting the words “; and”; and
 - by inserting after paragraph (d) the following paragraph —

“(e) hear and determine appeals made under section 16(4) of the *Mental Health Act (2022 Revision)*.”.

Passed by the Parliament the 10th day of October, 2022.
