In exercise of the powers conferred by section 34 of the Public Health Act (2002 Revision) the Cabinet makes the following Regulations —

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19 (Processions) Regulations, 2021.

Processions by a uniformed service or a youth organisation in Grand Cayman or Cayman Brac

2. (1) Notwithstanding regulations 3 and 4 of the *Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19 (Partial Lifting of Restrictions) Regulations, 2021*, a uniformed service or a youth organisation may hold a procession.
- (2) In this regulation —
- “**uniformed service**” means —
- (a) a naval force, including the Coast Guard;
 - (b) a regiment; and
 - (c) a police force, fire service or prison service; and
- “**youth organisation**” means —
- (a) Cayman Islands Scout Association;
 - (b) Girls’ Brigade Cayman Islands;
 - (c) Cayman Islands Cadet Corps;
 - (d) Girlguiding Cayman Islands; and
 - (e) Cayman Islands Conference of Seventh-day Adventists Pathfinders.

Repeal of the Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19 (Partial Lifting of Restrictions) (Processions) Regulations, 2020

3. The *Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19 (Partial Lifting of Restrictions) (Processions) Regulations, 2020* are repealed.
